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DEGREE PROGRAMS

The department of Visual Arts offers two programs of study leading to a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Graphic Design or Studio Arts and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Studio Arts.

The BFA Degree is a professional degree program that offers a balance of theoretical and practical skills complimented by the enriched experience of the liberal arts environment of Pacific. The goal of this degree is the development of skills, concepts and sensitivities essential to professional studio artists and graphic designers.

This degree is designed for students willing to engage in a rigorous undergraduate program that provides preparation for professional life through the internship, graduate studies or entry-level opportunities in the arts and arts-related fields.
